Dear Families of 3 year olds,

It is hard to believe that Christmas is just around the corner. It has been a pleasure getting to know the children and truly rewarding to see the growth already. They arrive each day excited to see their friends, and enthusiastic to learn. They are so much fun to spend time with.

Our theme in November was Community Helpers. The children learned who our community helpers are and how they help in our community. Thank you to Nurse, Shelley Cox, for visiting and teaching the children about how to stay healthy. Thank you also to Fire Fighter, Keith Peterson, for teaching us about fire safety and for the fireman's hat and coloring book. We had a short bus ride to visit Secord Dental. It was a great way to make going to the dentist fun. We laced a toothbrush necklace, played dentist bingo, made a healthy snack, and had a ride in the dentist chair.

I'd like to thank all of you for helping your children become excited about "The letter of the Week". The children are learning the sounds each letter makes, printing upper and lower case with chalk and sock, and finding words that begin with each letter. We will also continue to practice patterning, printing our names, learning numbers, and becoming more and more independent. I am so proud with the progress so far, thank you again for your support at home. Just a reminder, cutting up old magazines or flyers and printing their name are all good exercises for their fine motor development.

This trip will focus on a look at the past and how children celebrated Christmas long ago. Our classes are busy like elves making Christmas crafts, gifts, and practicing for our little concert. The children will be looking for you from up on the stage! Please meet in the gym to get a good seat for the concert - the times are posted on the calendar. 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## Literacy Moment



Reading to your preschooler is one of the most important things you can do to help them build vocabulary, reinforce letter recognition, and build pre-reading skills. Rhyming books are particularly helpful for skill development. Tired of reading the same books over and over? This "habit" helps reinforce literacy skills, so bear with "Good Night Moon" x 5,679 - it is actually beneficial. While you read, try to look for different elements in the pictures, use the opportunity to practice letter recognition, and play with rhyming to add a fresh perspective on an old favourite. That said, it is important to keep reading fun, so regularly getting new books from the library is a great way to increase exposure to new and exciting stories – for free! Happy reading!
